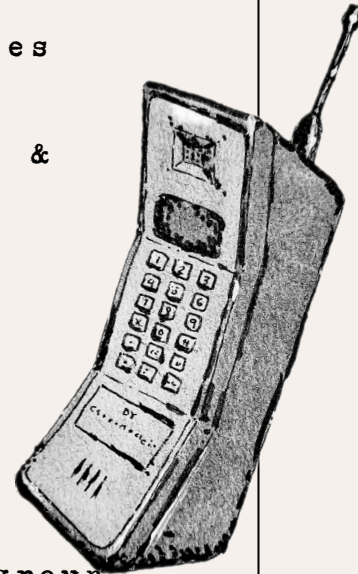

ICE has recently been seen frequenting Latin & Hispanic areas in Ypsilanti.

While some sightings have occurred in Ann Arbor, Ypsilanti is ICE's primary focus.

They have not yet taken action directly on school grounds, although Ypsilanti Community Schools confirmed ICE activity near schools. Some parents have been detained.

ICE has also been deployed to help w/ TSA, & their presence may be @ local airports.

★ immediate presence @ DTW has not been confirmed despite ICE being deployed @ other airports. DTW wait times have reportedly remained consistent before & after the shutdown, so ICE deployment is less likely.

Here are common indicators that a vehicle is associated w/ ICE:

- unmarked van, typically blue, white, or black
- "no smoking" stickers or barcodes on windows
- ★ both in & out-of-state vehicles

- tinted windows
- no license plates / FP ("fleet police") / paper "dealer" plates

### Common models

- Ford
- Chevrolet
- Dodge
- GMC
- Chevy Tahoes



# WATCH OUT FOR...

- multiple vans in a group
- masked individuals in the vehicle
- individuals wearing vests marked w/
  - "Police"
  - "HSI"
  - "ICE"
- multiple individuals wearing a hat, mask, & sunglasses w/ tactical gear  
some agents may wear plain clothes, so it is crucial to look for extra warning signs

\*be mindful of ICE's presence in Latin and Hispanic communities in MI, ESPECIALLY near Ypsi.
